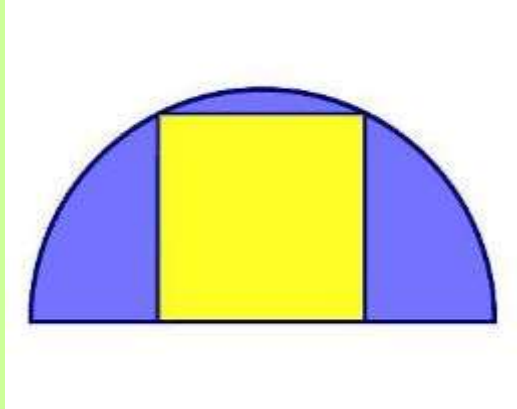

Jackets Have Arrived

- ◆ Is light
- ◆ Has two exterior zip-up pockets
- ◆ Has a soft, warm interior lining
- ◆ Is made of a wicking fabric that draws perspiration away from the skin to the outside layer of the jacket
- ◆ Is water resistant (not waterproof)
