Student Dress Code

Tully State High School (TSHS) Parents and Citizen's Association has resolved that it is compulsory for all students to wear the correct and full school uniform each day. The school uniform must be worn as per the policy. The uniform and accessories must be worn in compliance with Work Health and Safety standards, for the safety of all students and staff.

Daily Uniform

- TSHS blue polo short or TSHS long sleeve shirt or TSHS house polo shirt
- TSHS navy blue shorts
- Short, black or white socks
- Closed in, covered shoes appropriate for all schooling activities
- Year 12 only – Senior Jersey and/or Senior Polo shirt

Formal Uniform

A combination of either:

- TSHS navy pleated skirt and TSHS blue blouse; or
- TSHS navy tailored shorts and tailored blue buttoned shirt
- Formal events: TSHS tie and shirt tucked in (when required)

Worn on school days and for formal occasions/school ceremonies including: Leadership Induction, ANZAC Day, Speech Night, Photo Day, Graduation or whenever representing TSHS at a formal engagement.

Formal uniforms can be hired for official occasions from the library.

Sports Uniform

- TSHS House polo shirt
- Kirrama – yellow
 - Mackay – red
 - Tyson – blue
 - Walter Hill – green
- TSHS navy blue shorts

Sun Protection

- All students must wear a bucket hat or cap when outdoors during outside sport and class time activities, break times and before and after school
- Sunscreen is available, free from the HPE department

Winter Uniform

- TSHS navy pullover jumper with hood or TSHS navy jacket with red trim or a plain navy/black jacket/cardigan/jumper (no logo or embroidery)
- Black or navy leggings, stockings or tights must only be worn underneath TSHS formal skirt
- Plain navy blue or black trousers (no denim or trackpants)

Make-up

- If worn at all, make-up is to be light and natural and appropriate to a professional work environment, if not, students will be required to remove

Jewellery

- Jewellery is restricted to earrings (studs or small alternative), a watch & one unobtrusive chain necklace
 - Facial piercings are to be studs only
- At all times the wearing of any jewellery must comply with Work Health and Safety regulations. Non-complaint jewellery will be required to remove

Safety Standards

Compliance with the Work Health and Safety Act 2011, QLD, regulations on protective clothing

Out of Uniform Procedures

1. Student presents to main office with or without a note explaining why they are out of uniform.
 - If a clothing item, student to be provided with school uniform item and office retains non-uniform item for the day and recorded in ID attend. Uniform is exchanged at end of day
 - For footwear, office refers to relevant Deputy Principal for discussion and authorisation.
2. If student refuses to change uniform, referred to Head of Junior/Middle/Senior for discussion and parent contact.
3. If student presents to class or in playground out of uniform, staff refers student to main office to follow step 1.
4. Students who persistently present out of uniform will be followed up by Year Level Coordinator, Head of Junior/Middle/Senior or a relevant Deputy Principal.
