# What is SET Planning?

---

- SET Planning stands for ‘Senior Education and Training Plan’
- Every Year 10 student needs to complete one to re-enrol into senior schooling
- SET Plans require you as a student to start making decisions about what career pathways you want to undertake as you enter the final years of your schooling
- During this process there are key dates that you need to be aware of along with your parents/carers need to be involved in
- If not SET Plan is completed, you cannot continue into Year 11



# Important information for your SET Plan

---

- You need to complete a SET Plan to enrol into Year 11.
  - NO INTERVIEW, NO YEAR 11
- At your SET Plan meeting you need to:
  - Have an outline of your career options
  - Know what you need to get your career
  - Know and select those subject that you need to study
  - Be aware that not all subjects offered will run

## University

- Need an ATAR & meet prerequisites



## Trade or TAFE

- Need to be working towards a QCE and completing relevant work experience




## Employment

- This pathway is available to any student once 16yrs old

# What is an ATAR & QCE?

---

- All students enrolled into Year 11 are working towards achieving a QCE
- Only students looking at entering university are working towards an ATAR



# Subject/ course selection is vital!

---

- You may have to choose certain subjects to be eligible for your preferred pathway
- There are 3 types of subjects/ course available

## General Subjects

These subjects typically lead towards university  
You do not need to be going to university to study these subjects

## Applied Subjects

These subjects typically lead to a trade/ TAFE pathway or employment  
Students looking to go to university cannot study more than 2 of these


## Certificate Courses

These are trade based qualifications that typically lead to a trade or employment  
Students looking to go to university can only study Certificate III level courses


