<b>Wellbeing Program</b>	<b>All Year 10 Students - Tuesdays P1, Thursdays P4 – Delivered through QLearn</b> <i>Students engage in a range of learning experiences that develop their personal and social capabilities, emotional intelligence, 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills and awareness of the requirements for different pathways. Students will complete a Short Course in Career Education as part of their Wellbeing lessons. Successful completion of the course will earn students one Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) credit.</i>	Free
<b>Duke of Edinburgh Award</b>	<b>Opt-in opportunity – Completed in Wellbeing time and outside of school time to complete the requirements of the Award.</b> <i>This is an amazing opportunity for students to challenge themselves, build leadership qualities, step outside their comfort zone and grow as young adults! Students will enrol in the Bronze Award as part of the Duke of Edinburgh Award. Students will be required to complete 13hrs of voluntary service, 13 hrs of a skill, and 13 hours of physical recreation over a period of 3-4 months. Students will also complete an adventurous journey. Completion earns students one QCE credit and amazing memories.</i>  <i>If students have completed the Bronze Award, they will be able to enrol in the Silver Award. This will require them to complete 26hrs of voluntary service, 26 hours of a skill, and 26 hours of physical recreation over 6- 7 months. Students will also complete 1 practice and 1 final adventurous journey. <b>White Card Course</b>	<b>Opt-in opportunity - Tully SHS – Mon 16<sup>th</sup> March, Fri 15<sup>th</sup> May or Tues 1<sup>st</sup> of September</b> <i>A White Card is proof that you have completed general construction safety training. This training focuses on risk awareness, safe behaviour, and legal duties on construction sites and is nationally recognised. You may need a white card for some work experience placements including electrical and construction or you just want the qualification for the future. Submit Student Details form with three forms of ID and \$90 as soon as possible to secure your place. Strictly 15 places available for each course – this is a full day course.</i>	\$90

Students will participate in a mini exposure lesson of their nominated subjects to determine if it is something that they would like to study in Year 11. <b>JCU Residential Program</b>	<b>Opt-in opportunity - JCU Townsville - Term 2 Week 10 – Mon 22<sup>nd</sup> – Tues 23<sup>rd</sup> June</b> <i>Students will stay overnight on campus at either Saints or John Flynn College and interact with a range of university representatives in their interested fields as part of the JCU Schools Open Day program. This is an amazing opportunity to experience life on campus, try out lectures and learn more about the university pathway. <b>Work Experience</b>	<b>Compulsory – Far North Queensland – Term 2 Week 10 - Wed 24<sup>th</sup> – Fri 26<sup>th</sup> June</b> <i>Work experience is an excellent opportunity for all year 10 students to try out a job over 3 days. This provides students with an insight into what is involved in certain careers and can lead to further employment or apprenticeships. A list of suggested workplaces has been emailed out to families. Students are to submit an EOI (yellow form) to A17 with a list of three preferences for this placement. Once confirmed students will receive an agreement (white form) to be signed and returned to A17 or Mr Rohl. Students can also engage in further work experience during the holidays or terms 3 and 4. <b>Subject Selection</b>	<b>Compulsory for Year 10 Students - Tues Period 1 - Wellbeing Lesson - Term 3 Weeks 1-3</b> <i>Students will choose their subjects for Year 11. There will be multiple rounds occurring over 3 consecutive weeks as lines are refined to reflect student choices. Final subjects will be chosen in SET Plan Interviews.</i>	Free
<b>Open Night</b>	<b>Opt-in opportunity - Tully SHS - Term 3 Week 2 - Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> July</b> <i>Students and Parents are invited to roam around Tully SHS and engage with the wide range of subject and pathway stalls. This is an opportunity to discuss subjects with the Teachers and Heads of Department – Curriculum. There will be an information session scheduled about Senior School Pathways.</i>	Free
<b>SET Plan Interviews</b>	<b>Compulsory for all Year 10 Students – Term 3 Week 5 - Thurs 13<sup>th</sup> – Fri 14<sup>th</sup> August</b> <i>30 minute appointment times can be booked through SOBS in the email sent home in. Interviews will focus choosing subjects for 2027 to align with intended pathways. This is a requirement to re-enrol in Year 11. This is what students are working towards all year.</i>	Free
<b>Certificate II in Resources and Infrastructure</b>	<b>Opt-in opportunity - Tues 18<sup>th</sup> August – Thurs 12<sup>th</sup> November - Camp on 16<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> September - Full day courses Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> &amp; 27<sup>th</sup> of October &amp; Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> November</b> <i>Students will complete a Certificate II in Resources and Infrastructure, providing an entry level qualification in resources and infrastructure industries.
